REPLICATION OF STATEN ISLAND LIGHTHOUSE FOR USE AS CELLULAR ANTENNA DISGUISE STATEN ISLAND, NEW YORK

The community surrounding this key cellular tower objected to the visual impact on their neighborhood. Working with community representatives and the tower owner, Fiberglass Specialties, Inc was able to recreate a lighthouse that had previously stood on the site of the cell tower. The new tower is made from FSI "Clear Air" materials that allow for almost uninterrupted passage of the cell signal while providing an exceptionally strong, maintenance free surround for the tower itself. Onsite management systems for the cell tower are enclosed in the base of the lighthouse. Located 369' above sea level, the lighthouse is 130' tall with an average width of 25' tapering to 22' at the top.
